
MAINTENANCE TIPS:

GETTING YOUR RIG READY FOR WINTER

STEP-BY-STEP VIDEO FOR WINTERIZING YOUR SPRAY UNIT

If you've worked with Graham for any length of time, you know we're sticklers about equipment maintenance. Even the most durable spray equipment won't last as long or perform as well if it's not properly maintained. With winter around the corner, we show you in our new video how easy it is to protect components from freezing.

Go to GrahamSE.com and select "Videos" from the Show & Tell menu at the top of the page. Then scroll down a bit to find "How to Winterize Your Unit." Donny Pitts, Graham's general manager, shows you what you need to do to make sure your equipment is ready to perform come next spray season. The short video covers everything in the following checklist.

STEPS TO WINTERIZING YOUR GRAHAM SPRAY UNIT

- 1 Empty the tank.
- 2 Remove the strainer cap and screen.
- 3 Open the suction-line valves. Open the 1-inch ball valve on the suction line. If it's a double system, you'll have two 3-way valve handles. Cock them to a 45-degree angle so that both ends of the valve are partially open. If one side is left closed off, it can freeze and burst.
- 4 Remove the nozzles. Remove nozzles from all spray guns and fix the triggers in the open position. This will prevent the guns from freezing. Removing nozzles is a must.
- 5 Remove the plug from the regulator or open valve.
- 6 Open all valves on tanks including the drop valve.

- 7 Open the valves on the reels.
- 8 Turn the pump over until water stops leaking from the regulator.

The unit is now winterized, sparing you the hassle and expense of dealing with damaged equipment next spring and increasing the longevity of your spray unit.
